Rules for a White Elephant Gift Exchange 1. Each person brings one wrapped gift to contribute to a common pool. 2. Numbers are draw to determine gift selection order. 3. The person with number 1 selects a gift from the pool and opens it. 4. The person with number 2 either selects an unwrapped gift or steals the previous person gift. 5. Person number 3 selects an unwrapped gift or steals an opened gift and so on and so on. 6. If your gift is stolen, you have the option to pick an unwrapped gift or steal someone else's gift. 7. After everyone has had a turn, the person with number 1 gets a chance to swap the gift they are holding for any other opened gift, Anyone whose gift is stolen may steal from someone else. When someone declines to steal, the gift exchange comes to an end.

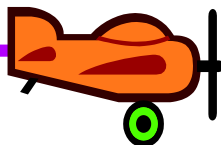

We will have a White Elephant Gift Exchange to contribute to a common pool. Rules of the exchange:

- 1. Each person brings one wrapped gift to contribute to a common pool.**
- 2. Numbers are drawn to determine gift selection order.**
- 3. The person with number one selects a gift from the pool and opens it.**
- 4. The person with number two either selects an unopened gift or steals the previous person's gift.**
- 5. Person number three either selects a wrapped gift or steals an opened one from person number one or two. Etc.**
- 6. If your gift is stolen you have the option to pick a wrapped gift or steal someone else's.**
- 7. After everyone has had a turn, the person with number one gets a chance to swap the gift they are holding for any other opened gift. Anyone whose gift is stolen has the option to steal from someone else. When someone declines to steal a gift, the gift exchange is at an end.**
