Get Ready For May! Our May meeting will highlight a Make-and-Take project at Ballou Skies hangar in Bucyrus, Ohio in which YOU can make a logoed shirt to take home! Jun and her 49 1/2 Rich, designed and digitized the All-Ohio 99s logo with a script border on the lower edge, shown on the left. It will be cut in heat transfer vinyl and applied by heat press to the garment or fabric of your choice. You have until the May meeting to purchase or choose a clean, washed garment that can sustain heat. Plastics are not a good choice, but cotton or blend would be suitable. New garments

should be washed to remove the sizing used in production. If you cannot make the May meeting but desire the decal you could attach it at home with an extremely hot iron (cotton/ linen setting) and cover cloth. Larger transfers could be applied on canvas to turn it into a tote bag. The design can also be cut in different vinyl for attaching to notebooks or nonclothing surfaces. Each design will cost a \$5 donation to the chapter. Royal blue, red, black and white are already available.
